

MOHA Meeting Updates

Today, MoHA called an early morning meeting to cluster and co-lead to give and get an update on each cluster; further to also discuss on sector wise assessment works. Few points discussed and decided:

Assessment

- 1) IRA- being done only in 6-7 districts by NRCS
- 2) IRA deadline for NRCS is tomorrow (Friday) for sharing the damage data
- 3) While this will come out for these districts and other information of initial damages, as per the agreed national guideline on assessment, we are supposed to initiate MIRA and then Cluster Specific Detailed Assessment (CSDA). With existing situation and flexibility provided by the national guideline, all clusters to prepare Cluster Specific Detailed Assessment (CSDA), which means we skip MIRA and do CSDA.
- 4) National WASH Cluster will review the WASH CSDA tool and share to all districts to prepare for CSDA.

Support Needs

- 1) Both protection and health cluster requested WASH cluster to provide hygiene kit- focusing pregnant and lactating mother families as the most vulnerable group
- 2) For hygiene kit distribution- focusing in pregnant and lactating mother families, would help us reduce the demand to provide to all people, which is practically not possible
- 3) Thus coordination with health and protection cluster could also help us in distribution of materials

Transportation needs

- 1) If there is need for water transportation, such as boats and rafts (in water bodies having more than 2 feet), we can contact APF team / HQ who is facilitating this for our response support. We will need specific locations for this support.
